Fundraising Campaign Reaches Halfway Point

A Regional Integrated Accessible Park is inching its way closer to becoming a reality. The proposed location is at Jubilee Park in Southampton. Located beside the Fire Station and the water tower, this is an ideal spot to meet the needs of all of our potential users and in the heart of the community.

The community launch occurred on Thursday, September 10th, and we are ecstatic to announce that a total of \$128,000 has been raised to date with an additional \$122,000 still required to be fundraised.

The Town of Saugeen Shores has generously pledged \$75,000 towards the project on the condition that the remaining amount be pledged by spring 2010 before moving forward with installation in June.
