



COUNTY OF BRUCE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS AND SPECIAL WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE 2010



Now is your chance to clean out the house/shed/garage/basement and remove potentially dangerous waste products and dispose of them in an environmentally safe manner, at NO COST. Hazardous materials are those that can **catch fire, react or explode** when mixed with other substances, if it's **corrosive**, or if it is **toxic**. Special wastes are materials such as **batteries, pressurized & aerosol containers, portable fire extinguishers, fertilizers, fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, pesticides, paints & coatings, oil bottles & filters, fluorescent light bulbs or tubes, pharmaceuticals, antifreeze & solvents**. Improper disposal of many household products in drains, sewers, backyards or landfill sites, is not only hazardous to public health but also contaminates our water supply and other natural resources. The following symbols indicate that the material is hazardous but be aware, not all products carry these symbols.

**CORROSIVE**

Batteries (household and auto),
Oven cleaners,

**TOXIC**

**REACTIVE**

Anti-freeze
