Re: Southampton North End Project

Saugeen River Directional Bore

As previously notified, a sanitary sewer forcemain is to be placed by directional boring underneath the bed of the Saugeen River, to convey the sewage from the north side of the Saugeen River to the Southampton Sewage Treatment Plant.

The forcemain will start at #1 Chesley Street (Chesley Street Boat Launch area) to the unopened road allowance between #326 and #334 Saugeen Street formally known as Smith Street. The forcemain will continue on Saugeen Street from approximately #326 Saugeen Street to Grey Street, Alice Street from Grey Street to Grenville Street and the unopened section of Grenville Street north of Alice Street.

One of the regulatory requirements is to complete an archaeological assessment of the forcemain route. The Town's archaeological consultant, Fisher Archaeological Consulting will be hand digging test pits along the forcemain route within the Town's right of way. The test pits may be in front of your property however the test pits are small and shallow and the grass and topsoil will be replaced.

These test pits are scheduled for either Monday, August 23rd or Tuesday, August 24th.

We wish to thank you in advance for your patience and co-operation during the construction period.
