Subject: **Port Elgin WWTP-Inlet Works Building**

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### **RECOMMENDATION**

**That Wellington Construction be awarded the work for the construction of the Inlet Works Building and associated works including the provisional odour control system in the amount of \$2,066,000.00 plus G.S.T. and that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary contract documents.**

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### **BACKGROUND**

Genivar prepared a tender (Contract OS-09-004-11-OS) for the construction of the Inlet Works Building and associated works at the Port Elgin Waste Water Treatment Plant.

The Town received eight Tenders as follows:

Included in the Tender:

1. A \$50,000.00 Contingency Allowance.
2. A septage receiving station that will pre-process the waste from septic systems before blending into the municipally collected sewage.
3. Provisional Item – A dual media odour control system.

Although the odour control system is a provisional item, staff is recommending that the odour control system be included in the Contract for health and safety of the operators as well as pre-treating the inlet sewage flows from the Harbour Street Sewage Pump Station and from the future Concession 10 Sewage Pump Station. The odour control system is another step in reducing the offensive odours resulting from the operation of the waste water control plant.

After the capital costs of the septage receiving station component are known, staff will present a Staff Report recommending a user fee for the increased service.

That Wellington Construction be awarded the work for the construction of the Inlet Works Building and associated works including the provisional odour control in the amount of \$2,066,000.00 plus G.S.T. and that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary contract documents.
