**NOTICE TO RESIDENTS
OF HIGHLAND STREET**

FROM MARKET STREET TO FALCONER STREET

TOWN OF SAUGEEN SHORES

As you are aware the contractor Omega Contractors, has started the installation of the sanitary sewer system for the Concession 10 project.

With all the recent rain and the high water table the contractor is planning to dewater the area. The dewatering means that small pipes will be inserted into the ground along the curb down to below the elevation that where the sanitary sewer is required to be installed. The small vertical pipes will be connected to a collection pipe that will be on the surface other than in front of your driveway where it will be lowered so your driveway can be ramped to maintain your access.

Although this will cause a slight delay initially in the installation of the sanitary sewer however it is anticipated that the dewatering will not prolong the construction as the contractor will be able to work faster without the issue of the ground water.

The Consulting Engineering firm that is working on behalf of the municipality is Genivar formerly Henderson Paddon & Associates of Owen Sound. If you have any questions or concerns with the day to day construction activities please contact the Genivar's site representative Mr. Fred Cathrae, who will normally be on-site during most activities. Ask any of the workers on-site to direct you to Fred.
