**NOTICE TO RESIDENTS
OF HIGHLAND STREET**

FROM FALCONER STREET TO SANDY ACRES ROAD

TOWN OF SAUGEEN SHORES

The Town of Saugeen Shores proposes to install a new sanitary sewer as part of the Concession 10 Sewage Pump Station project on Highland Street from Falconer Street to Sandy Acres Road.

The preferred route for this trunk sanitary sewer was designed to be placed west of Parkwood Drive along the top of the tablelands north to Concession 10. This was the preferred route as it minimized the disruption to the residents of the area and was primarily thru open green space.

During the approval process with the Ministry of Environment a significant archeological discovering was located close to the preferred sanitary sewer route. This archeological discovering forced the Town to investigate other options for the trunk sanitary sewer route to Concession 10 Sewage Pump Station. After consideration of all issues, the selected option was to reluctantly redesign the sewer and to replace the sanitary sewer on Highland Street.

Staff and Council of the Town of Saugeen Shores are very aware of the impact and the disruption to your way of life during this sanitary sewer installation. Circumstances out of the Town's control have dictated that your section of Highland Street is the route for this trunk sanitary sewer.

Upon completion of the sanitary sewer the contractor will restore the road to original condition.

It is anticipated that the work will start the week of April 3rd, 2009 and be completed by the end of June.

Vehicular access to your home will be maintained except when the Contractor is working in your immediate area. There are no planned interruptions of your water service for this project. If interruptions occur due to a waterline break or other unforeseeable circumstances, service will be restored as soon as possible.

The Contractor for the sanitary sewer project is Omega Contractors Inc.

The Consulting Engineering firm that is working on behalf of the municipality is Genivar formerly Henderson Paddon & Associates of Owen Sound.
