## General Camp Rules

1. Register at the Camp Office before occupying a site.
2. Check in is 3:00 pm
3. Check out is 12:00 pm (noon)
4. Quiet hours begin at 11:00 pm. Radios must be turned down at this time.
5. All fires must be extinguished by 1:30 am.
6. Alcohol is not permitted off of your site.
7. Smoking is not permitted in washroom facilities.
8. Visitors to your site are not permitted to enter the park after 10:00 pm and must leave the camp by 12:00 am (midnight).
9. Campers wishing to change sites must obtain approval from Camp staff prior to moving.
10. Maximum of 6 people per site, including children.
11. Maximum of 1 trailer or tent per site.
12. Propane canisters must be disposed of properly. Do not put in household garbage. Please ask Camp staff where to dispose of used canisters.
13. Pets must be leashed and kept under control at all times.
14. Campers must not deface camp property.
15. Staff will collect your transient garbage. Please leave it in a garbage bag in the bins provided on your lot. Garbage bags are available at the Camp Office.

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
