

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

Town of Saugeen Shores Transportation Master Plan Study

The **Town of Saugeen Shores Transportation Master Plan** (TMP) is a strategic policy document that directs how the municipality's transportation system will grow and develop over the long term. The TMP examines current traffic and transportation issues within the community, assesses existing and future growth patterns, determines the need for transportation improvements, and establishes policies to establish and maintain the needed transportation network.

The TMP Study was completed in accordance with the requirements of Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA), an approved process under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*, including extensive public consultation. The study addresses transportation needs and justification at a broad level, so the recommended infrastructure projects will require further examination and detailed study to complete the requirements of the Municipal Class EA prior to implementation.

The study produced the Town's first TMP, which was received by Town Council on November 23, 2020. This notice places the new TMP on public record for a 30-day comment period to conclude the requirements of the Municipal Class EA process. Comments must be received by February 10, 2021 to become part of the public record for the study. You can download the TMP document from the study web site <https://www.saugeenshores.ca/tmp>.
