- Provide first aid services as required and document accordingly
- Respond to inquiries and concerns from the general public, participants and/or parents

- Educate/inform all individual/groups concerning pool and equipment rules and regulations, ensuring their observance to maintain a safe, enjoyable pool environment
- Promote water safety within the community
- Perform other duties as trained and required
