Summary of Duties:

The Town of Saugeen Shores is seeking a Labourer in the Public Works department. This position reports to the Shop Lead Hand / Supervisor.

Major Responsibilities:

- Perform preventative maintenance on the Town's infrastructure including:
 - Culvert repair and installation
 - Manhole and Chamber repairs and construction
 - Maintenance of Public Works buildings, including painting, carpentry and cleaning
 - Washing of Public Works vehicles and equipment
- Trench shoring and support system construction
- Weed cutting, grass cutting, tree trimming and brush removal, ditch cleaning
- Manual snow removal
- Snow plow operation
- Repair and replacement of traffic signs, road signs and guardrails
- Assist with sidewalk replacement
- Other duties as assigned
