NOTE: If someone other than the names listed as an Authorized Pick-up tries to collect your camper from a Town of Saugeen Shores camp program, leaders will be required to contact a Primary Contact and obtain consent to release the camper.

NOTE: Campers must be 10 years of age or older in order to arrive or depart from programs unsupervised. These campers must have written permission from the Primary Contact prior to camp start. Campers who are authorized to leave camp unsupervised will not be released until the end of day at 4:00pm. Once the camper has signed themselves out of camp, camp councilors are no longer responsible for said camper.

### Emergency Medical Treatment

In the event of an accident or illness involving my child while attending the program, I hereby authorize, if I am not immediately available, the administration of any medical procedure deemed necessary by the child's physician, or any other physician selected by the program staff. I also give my permission for my child to be transported to the physician's office or the hospital Emergency Department with no liability on the driver's part. An ambulance may be called to transport my child to the hospital if required; billing for the ambulance will be forwarded to the main contact specified on the registration form.

### Excursions off the Property

The child(ren) included in this form may be taken away from the program premises by the staff, by means of any manner of public or private transportation or otherwise, for walks, picnics or outings of any kind and may, from time to time, be scheduled as part of the program.

Routine activities for all camps may include walking to and from the park, walking on trails and around the facility as well as using the green space in and around the facility.

Please note staff do not drive participants for any reason; Aquatic Specialty Camps will travel by bus as indicated in the camp description. Sport Crew will require bikes for transportation on specific days during the week as designated by the camp lead.

### Consent for Snacks and Treats

Some leaders may choose to give out food during the week. This may include treats such as freezies, popsicles or ice cream or pre-packaged snacks such as granola bars, apple sauce, fruit snacks, bear paws, popcorn etc. Allergens declared on the consent form will not be served to your camper. A listing of special treat days will be noted within the weekly camper email.

### Publicity Authorization

The assigned camper(s) may appear in advertising/publicity arranged by the Town of Saugeen Shores through various media outlets including newspaper, radio, tv, social media, slide presentations and printed or other electronic publications.

### Camper Code of Conduct

The Town of Saugeen Shores Aquatic Camps aim to provide a fun, respectful and supportive environment for all involved. Program staff are trained with safety and quality as

the top priorities. To maintain a high quality of programming, camp wide rules and expectations are upheld to continue to foster a safe, inclusive and positive camp experience for everyone.

Campers are expected to show up each and every day with a positive attitude ready to participate in all games and activities. Campers are to be kind to one-another, take turns and utilize fair-play practices during both structured and unstructured activity time. Campers are to show respect to their leaders by practicing good listening skills, as well as demonstrate respectful practices with the equipment and facilities by reporting damages and using equipment safely and with a designated purpose. While camp can be a lot of fun, it's essential to remember to keep our hands to ourselves and remember "hands-off" while interacting with others.

Any camper who diminishes the camp experience for peers, leaders or themselves may be removed from programming. Note that mistreatment, inappropriate language, aggressive actions and violent or physical behaviours will not be tolerated.

## Accommodation and Support

As the camper's parent or guardian, I understand it is my responsibility to organize our own support as the Town of Saugeen Shores does not offer an internal inclusion program. I acknowledge that I have been informed of the available resources within the community if this need is applicable to the child(ren) within my care.

## Arrival and Departure

As the camper's parent or guardian, I understand it is my responsibility to ensure my camper(s) arrive to camp each morning, and get home safe each night.

By selecting **Walking, Unsupervised** and/or **Biking, Unsupervised** for one or more of the children in my care, I release the Town of Saugeen Shores from any responsibility for their care prior to the arrival at camp and once they have been released at the end of the camp day (4:00pm).
